

## Intercultural Training – 22.5 hours per week

Our Intercultural Training course is designed to help teachers or administrative staff in an educational institution to develop their understanding of the meaning, value and significance of cultural diversity in relation to their professional practice.

Participants will have opportunities to:

- explore and become aware of their own identity and value system;
- think about how to develop empathy and sensitivity towards others;
- get to know their 'cultural glasses';
- discuss strategies to improve intergroup relations;
- identify bias and understand the harm that it inflicts upon individuals and society; and,
- develop their appreciation of the value and benefits of diversity.

The course will incorporate a mixture of individual work and work with partners, as well as opportunities to reflect upon the issues raised and discussed within a larger group.
