In addition to arranging homestay accommodation, we will book airport transfers (arrival and departure), and collect city bus passes for your group. We also organise an online placement test for all students so everyone starts at the right level.

We prioritise the safety and wellbeing of all groups of young learners from start to finish. We work with you to arrange accommodation with homestay hosts, and a member of our safeguarding team is available 24 hours, 7 days a week to help in any emergency.



SAFETY AND SECURITY

We are proud that Norwich has been ranked as one of the UK's safest cities. We ensure that all students know their way around our school and the city, and provide guidance on travel to and from school each day. Every young learner also receives a student card with our emergency contact details, so they can contact a member of staff whenever they need help.



A SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITY

We want our students to feel safe and happy at all times. From our welcoming homestay hosts and airport transfer service to our experienced teachers, support staff and activity leaders, we work hard to support our students at every stage of their studies. We also encourage our students to make new friends and get involved in our friendly, international community.





OUR SAFEGUARDING TEAM

Our safeguarding team work together across all areas of our school and activities to ensure every student has a safe, productive and enjoyable experience. All members of the team receive appropriate safeguarding training, and a member of staff is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to help with any problems or emergencies.



HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Our homestay hosts are carefully selected, and welcome students of different ages, religions, cultures and nationalities. They can cater to specific dietary requirements, and are regularly checked and inspected by our Accommodation Officer. All homestay hosts have also passed criminal record (DBS) checks and completed appropriate safeguarding training.





MEDICAL CARE

First-aid trained staff are available on site every day and during all social activities organised by the school. Our local medical facilities include a nearby NHS walk-in centre and the Norwich and Norfolk Hospital.
